# Batik Magic

Quilt by Nancy Mahoney


Size: 60" x 72"

## Yardage

3/8 yard each of 9 assorted dark purple batiks
3/8 yard each of 9 assorted medium green batiks
13/8 yard of black batik for borders and binding
33/4 yards of backing fabric

#### **Tools**

- Rotary Cutter (45 mm)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18")
- Rulers: 6" x 12" ruler and 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler
- Sewing Machine and Basic Sewing Supplies (scissors, pins, thread, seam ripper, and any special sewing tools you use.)
  - Iron and ironing surface (if *not* provided by guild)



## Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric.

# From assorted dark purple batiks, cut a total of:

• 22 (2½"-wide) strips; crosscut into:

40 (2½" x 6½") A rectangles 100 (2½" x 4½") B rectangles

40 (2½") C squares

• 11 (1½"-wide) strips; crosscut 1 strip into 8 (1½" x 3½") D rectangles.\*

### From assorted medium green batiks, cut a total of:

• 22 (2½"-wide) strips; crosscut into:

40 (2½" x 6½") A rectangles

100 (2½" x 4½") B rectangles

40 (2½") C squares

• 11 (1½"-wide) strips; crosscut 1 strip into 8 (1½" x 3½") D rectangles.\*

#### From black batik, cut:

- 7 (2½"-wide) outer-border strips. Piece the strips and cut 2 (2½" x 68½") strips and 2 (2½" x 60½") strips.
- 6 (1½"-wide) inner-border strips. Piece the strips and cut 2 (1½" x 60½") strips and 2 (1½" x 50½") strips.
- 8 (2¼"-wide) binding strips

Note: The purple and green  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide strips and D rectangles, as well as the black inner and outer border strips, and black binding strips are not needed for class.
