

Chocolate Caramel Stars

Finished size: 42" x 42"

Materials

Refer to the Fabric Key on the next page for fabric placement guidance. You can use my colors, choose your own colors, or make a scrappy project.

- 1 1/2 yards of light print (A)
- 1 yard of brown print (B)
- 5/8 yard of black print (C)
- 3/8 yard of beige print (D)
- 3/8 yard of tan print (E)
- 1/2 yard of binding fabric ★
- 2 7/8 yard of backing fabric ★

★ Binding and backing fabrics are not needed for class.

Basic Supplies

- Rotary Cutter (45 mm or small cutter)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18")
- Rulers:
 - 6" x 12" ruler
 - 1" x 6" ruler for paper piecing (Add-A-Quarter ruler optional)
- Washable glue stick
- Wooden pressing tool
- Sewing machine and Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, thread, seam ripper, and any special sewing tools you use.)

\$3.00 materials fee payable in class for foundation patterns.

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof). Before class, cut the following pieces. Pieces that have a ★ are not needed for the class.

From the light print (A), cut:

- (5) 2 1/4" x wof strips; cut into (80) 2 1/4" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to yield 160 half-square triangles.
- (1) 6 7/8" x wof strip; cut into (4) 6 7/8" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally to yield (16) quarter-square triangles
- (2) 3 5/8" x wof strips; cut into:
 - (16) 3 5/8" squares
 - (4) 3 1/2" border squares
- (7) 1 1/2" x wof strips; cut into:
 - (3) 1 1/2" x 25 1/2" sashing strips
 - (2) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" sashing strips
 - (2) 1 1/2" x 27 1/2" sashing strips
- (2) 4" x wof strips; cut into (20) 4" squares ★

From the brown print (B), cut:

- (5) 2 1/4" x wof strips; cut into:
 - (48) 2 1/4" squares; cut each square in half diagonally to yield 96 half-square triangles.
 - (32) 2" squares
- (2) 3 1/2" x 36 1/2" outer-border strips ★
- (2) 3 1/2" x 42 1/2" outer-border strips ★

From the black print (C), cut:

- (2) 3 1/4" x wof strips; cut into:
 - (32) 2" x 3 1/4" rectangles
 - (4) 3" squares
- (1) 2 1/4" x wof strips; cut into (16) 2 1/4" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to yield 32 half-square triangles.
- (4) 1 1/4" x wof strips; cut into:
 - (2) 1 1/4" x 30 1/2" middle-border strips ★
 - (2) 1 1/4" x 29" middle-border strips ★
- (1) 4" x wof strips; cut into (10) 4" squares ★

From the beige print (D), cut:

- (24) 2 3/4" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield 48 half-square triangles
- (16) 2" squares

From the tan print (E), cut:

- (1) 4" x wof strips; cut into (10) 4" squares ★
- (4) 1 1/2" x wof strips; cut into:
 - (2) 1 1/2" x 27" inner-border strips ★
 - (2) 1 1/2" x 29" inner-border strips ★

From the binding fabric, cut:

- (5) 2 1/4" x wof binding strips ★

For **ONE** block, you'll need the following pieces:

From the light print (A):

- (20) 2¼" squares, cut into (40) 2¼" half-square triangles
- (1) 6⅞" square, cut into (4) 6⅞" quarter-square triangles
- (4) 3⅝" squares

From the black print (C):

- (8) 2" x 3¼" rectangles
- (4) 2¼" squares, cut into (8) 2¼" half-square triangles

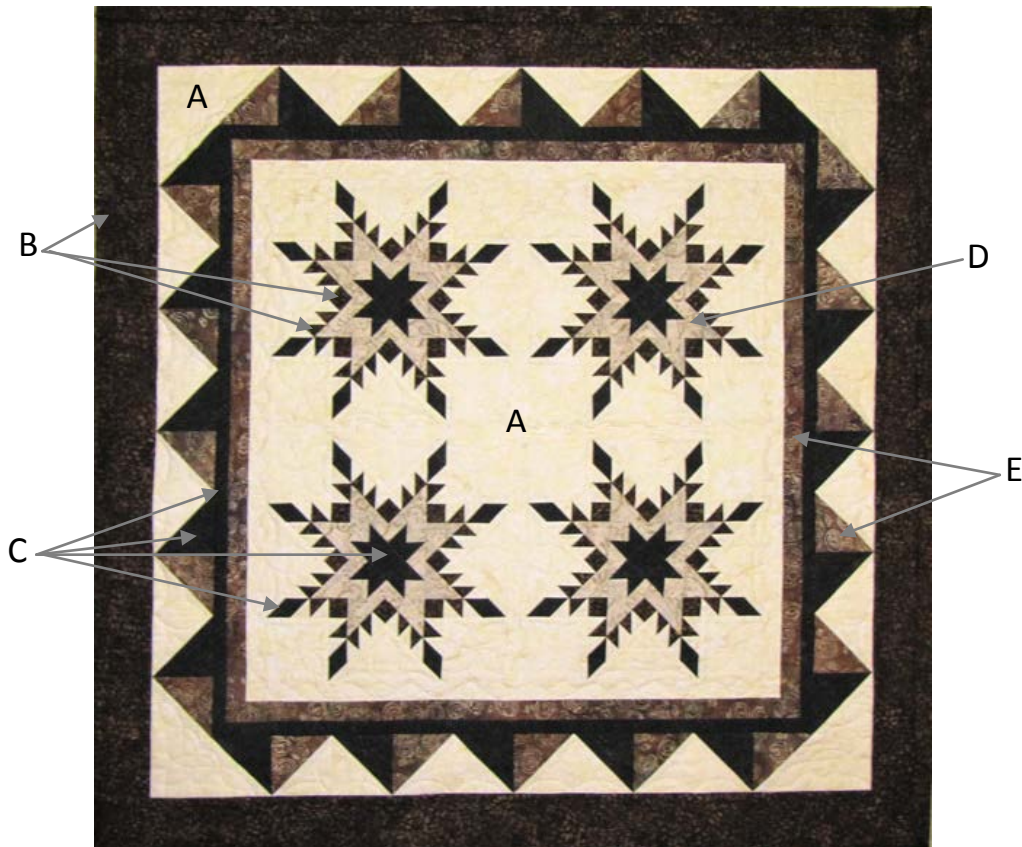
- (1) 3" square

From the brown print (B):

- (12) 2¼" squares, cut into (24) 2¼" half-square triangles
- (8) 2" squares

From the beige print (D):

- (6) 2¾" squares, cut into (12) 2¾" half-square triangles
- (4) 2" squares
