

Yardage

Fabric A	IPLY 681 MU	$1^{1/2}$ yards
Fabric B	IPLY 682 K	$^{1}/_{2}$ yard
Fabric C	IPLY 682 W	1 yard
Fabric D	IPLY 683 MU	1 yard
Fabric E	IPLY 684 K	3/4 yard
Fabric F	IPLY 685 G	3/4 yard
Fabric G	IPLY 686 B	1 ³ / ₈ yards
Fabric H	IPLY 686 O	3/4 yard
Backing	any IPLY fabric	4 ¹ / ₄ yards

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of the fabric.

From fabric A (IPLY 681 MU), cut:

- (3) 6 1/2" x 42" strips; crosscut into (15) 6 1/2" squares
- (8) 3 ¹/₂" x 42" outer-border strips. Piece the strips and cut (2) 3 ¹/₂" x 74 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 3 ¹/₂" x 68 ¹/₂" strips.

From fabric B (IPLY 682 K), cut:

• (6) 2" x 42" strips

From fabric C (IPLY 682 W), cut:

 (5) 5 ³/₄" x 42" strips; crosscut into (30) 5 ³/₄" squares

From fabric D (IPLY 683 MU), cut:

• (5) 5 3/4" x 42" strips; crosscut into (30) 5 3/4" squares

From fabric E (IPLY 684 K), cut:

• (10) 2" x 42" strips

From fabric F (IPLY 685 G), cut:

• (10) 2" x 42" strips; crosscut into (60) 2" x 5 3/4" strips

From fabric G (IPLY 685 B), cut:

- (7) 2" x 42" strips; crosscut 1 of the strips into (15) 2" squares
- (7) 1 ¹/₂" x 42" inner-border strips. Piece the strips and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 72 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 62 ¹/₂" strips.
- (8) 2 1/4" x 42" binding strips


From fabric H (IPLY 685 O), cut:

• (10) 2" x 42" strips

Block Y Assembly

Refer to the quilt image for color placement guidance throughout.

1. Sew a fabric B strip to the long edge of a fabric G strip to make a strip set. Make six strip sets and crosscut them into (120) 2"-wide segments.



2. Join two segments from step 1 to make a four-patch unit. Make 60 units.




3. Sew a fabric E strip to the long edge of a fabric H strip to make a strip set. Make 10 strip sets and crosscut them into (60) 6 1/2″-wide segments.

4. Join four units from step 2, four segments from step 3, and one fabric A square in three rows. Then join the rows to make one Y block. Make a total of 15 Y blocks.



Block Z Assembly


5. Join two fabric C squares, two fabric D squares, four fabric F rectangles, and one fabric G square in three rows. Then join the rows to make one Z block. Make a total of 15 Z blocks.





Quilt Assembly & Finishing

- **6.** Lay out the blocks in six rows of five blocks each, alternating the blocks in each row and from row to row as shown in the quilt image. Join the blocks into rows and then join the rows.
- **7.** Sew fabric G 72 $^{1/2}$ ″-long strips to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew fabric G 62 $^{1/2}$ ″-long strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top to complete the inner border.
- **8.** Sew fabric A 74 ¹/₂"-long strips to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew fabric A 68 ¹/₂"-long strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top to complete the outer border.
- **9.** Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the fabric G 2 1/4″-wide binding strips, bind the edges to finish.
