LTEX 770 N 1% yards Navy linen for blocks A & B and border

FWEA 208 B 1¾ yards

Royal blue weave for outer border & binding

Turquoise linen for block B

LTE2 770 OO ½ yard

Orange linen for block B

**FWEA 208 C** ½ yard Light purple weave for block A

**SAND 191 O** ½ yard

Gold sand for block A

LTE2 770 BG % yard

Green linen for block A

SAND 191 C ½ yard Dark purple sand for blocks A & B

LTEX 770 C 1/3 yard

Dark purple linen for block B

Backing 4 yards

# Cutting.....

From the light purple weave:

• (8) 11/2" x 42" strips

From the gold sand:

• (8) 1½" x 42" strips

From the green linen:

• (4) 2½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (52) 2½" squares

From the dark purple sand:

- (4) 11/2" x 42" strips
- (13) 2½"squares

#### From the navy linen:

- (7) 6½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (100) 2½" x 6½" rectangles
- (4) 3½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (40) 3½" squares

#### From the orange linen:

- (8) 11/2" x 42" strips
- (12) 2½" squares

#### From the turquoise linen:

- (6) 2½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (96) 2½" squares
- (4) 1½" x 42" strips

#### From the dark purple linen:

• (3) 2½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (48) 2½" squares


#### From the royal blue weave:

- (7) 5½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (44) 5½" squares
- (7) 21/4" x 42" binding strips

### Construction .....

#### Block A

- 1. Sew a 1½"-wide light purple weave strip to one long side of each 1½"-wide gold sand strip. Press the seams toward the purple strips. Make (8) strip sets. Crosscut into 1½"-wide segments. Cut 208 segments. Sew the segments together in pairs to make 104 four-patch units.
- 2. Sew together (4) four-patch units, (4) green linen squares, and (1) dark purple sand square to make a nine-patch unit. Make 13 units.
- 3. Referring to the photo, sew together (4) four-patch units, (4) navy linen rectangles, and (1) ninepatch unit from step 2 to make a block. Make 13 A blocks.




#### Block B

- **4.** Sew a 1½"-wide dark purple sand strip to one long side of a 1½"-wide orange linen strip. Press the seams toward the purple strips. Make (4) strip sets. Crosscut into 1½"-wide segments. Cut 96 segments. Sew the segments together in pairs to make 48 four-patch units.
- 5. Sew together (4) four-patch units from step 4, (4) dark purple linen squares, and (1) orange linen square to make a nine-patch unit. Make 12 units.
- 6. Sew a 1½"-wide turquoise strip to one long side of a 1½"-wide orange linen strip. Press the seams toward the orange strips. Make (4) strip sets. Crosscut into 1½"-wide segments. Cut 96 segments. Sew the segments together in pairs to make 48 four-patch units.
- 7. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each turquoise linen square. Place a marked square on each end of a navy rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess fabric

leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle. Make 48 units.

8. Sew together (4) four-patch units from step 6, (4) units from step 7, and (1) nine-patch unit from step 5 to make a block. Make 12 B blocks.



#### **Quilt Assembly**

- **9.** Arrange blocks A and B in five rows of five blocks each, alternating the blocks in each row and from row to row. Sew the blocks together into rows. Press the seams toward the A blocks. Sew the rows together; press.
- 20. To make the border units; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each navy linen square. Place a marked square on one corner of a royal blue square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle. Make 40 units.
- **11.** Sew (10) border units together as shown in the photo to make a border row. Make four border rows.
- **12.** Sew a border row to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew a royal blue square to both ends of each remaining border row and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- **13.** Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish. Add a label to the back of your quilt and enjoy!

LTE2 770 JJ ½ yard Peach linen for block A appliqués

FWEA 208 L ½ yard Lilac weave for block B

**SAND 191 YG** % yard Green sand for block A & appliqués

LTE2 770 LT ⅓ yard Light turquoise linen for block B

LTEX 770 Y ¼ yard Yellow linen for block A appliqués & block B

**FWEA 208 LP** ¼ yard Light pink weave for block A

Lilac linen for block B

Backing 4 yards

# Cutting .....

From the light pink weave:

• (4) 11/2" x 42" strips

From the green sand:

- (4) 11/2" x 42" strips
- (52) leaves for appliqué (Piece # 2)

From the cream linen:

• (4) 6½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (52) 2½" x 6½" rectangles

From the cream weave:

- (6) 6½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (13) 6½" squares and (48) 2½" x 6½" rectangles
- (4) 3½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (40) 3½" squares
- (4) 11/2" x 42" strips

From the peach linen:

• (52) tulips for appliqué (Piece # 1)

From the lilac weave:

• (8) 11/2" x 42" strips

From the light turquoise linen:

• (3) 2½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (48) 2½" squares

From the lilac linen:

• (1) 2½" x 42" strip; crosscut into (12) 2½" squares

From the yellow linen:

- (4) 11/2" x 42" strips
- (52) flower centers for appliqué (Piece # 4)

From the light blue sand:

- (6) 2½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (96) 2½" squares
- (208) flower petals for appliqué (Piece # 3)

From the green weave:

- (7) 5½" x 42" strips; crosscut into (44) 5½" squares
- (7) 21/4" x 42" binding strips

### Construction .....

#### Block A

- 1. Sew a 1½"-wide light pink weave strip to one long side of each 1½"-wide green sand strip. Press the seams toward the green strips. Make (4) strip sets. Crosscut into 1½"-wide segments. Cut 104 segments. Sew the segments together in pairs to make 52 four-patch units.
- 2. Sew together (4) four-patch units, (4) cream linen rectangles, and (1) 6½" cream weave square to make a block. Make 13 blocks.

3. Prepare the appliqué shapes for the appliqué method of your choice. Referring to the photo and the appliqué placement guide, position the shapes in the center of each block. Use matching thread to appliqué in place. Make 13 A blocks.



#### Block B

- 4. Sew a 1½"-wide lilac weave strip to one long side of a cream weave strip. Press the seams toward the lilac strips. Make (4) strip sets. Crosscut into 1½"-wide segments. Cut 96 segments. Sew the segments together in pairs to make 48 four-patch units.
- 5. Sew together (4) four-patch units from step 4, (4) light turquoise linen squares, and (1) lilac linen square together to make a nine-patch unit. Make 12 units.
- **6.** Repeat step 4 using the remaining lilac weave strips and the yellow linen strips. Make 48 four-patch units.
- 7. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each light blue sand square. Place a marked square on each end of a cream weave rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle. Make 48 units.
- 8. Sew together (4) four-patch units from step 6, (4) units from step 7, and (1) nine-patch unit from step 5 to make a block. Make 12 B blocks.

**Quilt Assembly** 

Refer to steps 9 — 13 for the *Bejeweled Basics* quilt for details. Sew the blocks together. Use the 3½" cream weave squares and the green weave squares to make the border. Sew the border to the quilt top. Bind to finish.
