## Yardage ~

**EBLO 867E** 1 1/3 yards

*Cream vine for blocks and pieced border*

**EBLO 864D** 1 1/8 yards

*Red large floral for outer border and binding*

**EBLO 867G** 5/8 yard

*Green vine for blocks and pieced border*

**EBLO 868E** 5/8 yard

*Neutral little berries for blocks and pieced border*

**EBLO 867KD** 5/8 yard

*Red-and-black vine for blocks and pieced border*

**EBLO 867D** 5/8 yard

*Red vine for blocks and pieced border*

**EBLO 866D** 1/2 yard

*Red winter berries for blocks and pieced border*

**EBLO 867GG** 1/2 yard

*Light green vine for blocks*

**EBLO 863D** 1/2 yard

*Red check for pieced border*

**EBLO 868D** 1/2 yard

*Red little berries for pieced border*

**EBLO 868G** 3/8 yard

*Green little berries for blocks*

**BACKING** 4 yards

*Any Enduring Blooms fabric*

From the neutral little berries, cut:

- 6 strips, 2 7/8" x 42"; crosscut into (72) 2 7/8" squares

From the red magnolia floral, cut:

- 2 strips, 4 1/2" x 42"

From the green magnolia floral, cut:

- 2 strips, 4 1/2" x 42"

From the light green vine, cut:

- 1 strip, 4 1/2" x 42"
- 6 strips, 1 1/2" x 42"

From the red-and-black vine, cut:

- 1 strip, 4 1/2" x 42"
- 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 42"; crosscut into (24) 2 1/2" squares
- 6 strips, 1 1/2" x 42"

From the green little berries, cut:

- 4 strips, 2 1/2" x 42"; crosscut into (52) 2 1/2" squares

From the red vine, cut:

- 8 strips, 2 1/2" x 42"; crosscut into (120) 2 1/2" squares

From the red little berries, cut:

- 4 strips, 2 7/8" x 42"; crosscut into (44) 2 7/8" squares

From the red check, cut:

- 4 strips, 2 7/8" x 42"; crosscut into (44) 2 7/8" squares

From the red large floral, cut:

- 7 border strips, 3" x 42"
- 7 binding strips, 2 1/4" x 42"

## Construction ~

### BLOCK A

**1.** Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each 2 7/8" cream square. Layer a marked square with each red winter-berries square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press the seams toward the red. Make 120 half-square triangle units. (Set aside 16 units for border block D.)

**2.** Repeat step 1, using the green vine and the neutral little-berries squares to make 144 half-square triangle units. (Set aside 48 units for block B and 44 units for border blocks.)

## Cutting ~

From the cream vine, cut:

- 4 strips, 6 1/2" x 42"; crosscut into (60) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- 5 strips, 2 7/8" x 42"; crosscut into (60) 2 7/8" squares
- 8 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

From the red winter berries, cut:

- 5 strips, 2 7/8" x 42"; crosscut into (60) 2 7/8" squares

From the green vine, cut:

- 6 strips, 2 7/8" x 42"; crosscut into (72) 2 7/8" squares

**3.** Sew a 1 1/2"-wide light green vine strip to both long sides of each red magnolia strip. Press the seams toward the green strips. Make two strip sets. Cut 4 1/2"-wide segments, 13 total.

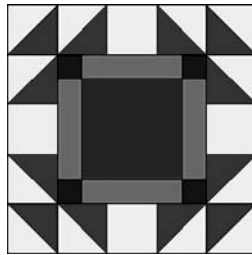
**4.** Sew a 1 1/2"-wide red-and-black vine strip to both long sides of the 4 1/2"-wide light green strip. Press the seams toward the green strips. Make one strip set. Cut 1 1/2"-wide segments, 26 total.

**5.** Sew one segment from step 3 between two segments from step 4 to make a center unit. Make 13 center units.

**6.** Sew one green little-berries square between two half-square units from step 1 to make a side unit. Make 52 side units.



**7.** Sew four half-square units from step 2, four side units, and one center unit together to make block A. Make 13 A blocks.



## BLOCK B

**8.** Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each red vine square. Place a marked square on each end of a cream rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the red. Make 60 units. (Set aside 12 units for border block C.)

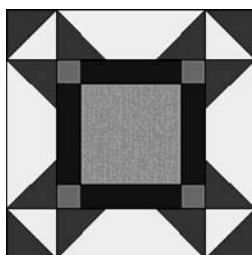


**9.** Sew a 1 1/2"-wide red-and-black vine strip to both long sides of each green magnolia strip. Press the seams toward the red-and-black strips. Make two strip sets. Cut 4 1/2"-wide segments, 12 total.

**10.** Sew a 1 1/2"-wide light green vine strip to both long sides of the 4 1/2"-wide red-and-black vine strip. Press the seams toward the red-and-black strips. Make one strip set. Cut 1 1/2"-wide segments, 24 total.

**11.** Sew one segment from step 9 between two segments from step 10 to make a center unit. Make 12 center units.

**12.** Sew four half-square units from step 2, four units from step 8, and one center unit from step 11 together to make block B. Make 12 B blocks.



## BORDER BLOCK C, D AND CORNER BLOCKS

**13.** Repeat step 1, using the red check and the red little-berries squares to make 88 half-square triangle units. (Set aside 32 units for border block D and 8 units for corner blocks.)

**14.** Sew four half-square units from step 13, two half-square units from step 2, one unit from step 8, and one red-and-black vine square together to make border block C. Make 12 of border block C.



**15.** Sew four half-square units from step 13, two half-square units from step 1, two half-square units from step 2, one 2 1/2" cream square, and one red-and-black vine square together to make border block D. Make 8 of border block D.



**16.** Sew two half-square units from step 13, one half-square unit from step 2, and one red-and-black vine square together to make a corner block. Make 4 corner blocks.



## Quilt Assembly ~

**17.** Arrange blocks A and B in five rows of five blocks each, alternating the blocks in each row and from row to row. Sew the blocks together into rows. Press the seams toward the A blocks. Sew the rows together; press.

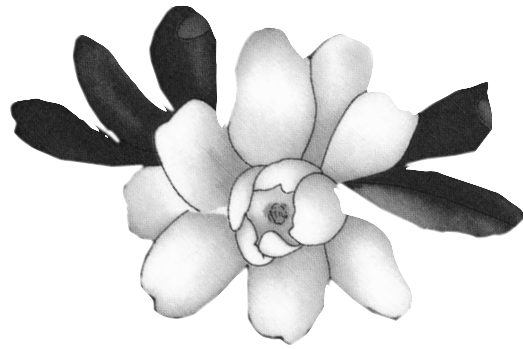
**18.** Alternately sew together border blocks C and D, starting and ending with block C, to make a border row. Press the seams toward block D. Make four border rows.

**19.** Sew a border row to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew a corner block to both ends of each remaining border row and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

**20.** Sew the 3"-wide floral strips end to end; press. Measure the quilt length through the center, cut two strips to this measurement and sew them to the sides of the quilt top. Measure the quilt width through the center, including the just added borders. Cut two strips to this measurement and sew them to the top and bottom. Press all seams toward the newly added borders.

**21.** Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish. Add a label to the back of your quilt and enjoy!





## Construction ~

*Note: Refer to the Holiday Quilt for complete instructions and diagrams.*

### **BLOCK A**

1. Referring to step 1 of the Holiday Quilt, and using the  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cream squares and the black winter-berries squares make 120 half-square triangle units. (Set aside 16 units for border block D.)
2. Use the red vine and the neutral little-berries squares to make 144 half-square triangle units. (Set aside 48 units for block B and 44 units for border blocks.)
3. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide green-on-black check strip to both long sides of each  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " black magnolia strip. Press the seams toward the green-on-black strips. Make four strip sets. Cut  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide segments, 25 total.
4. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide black magnolia strip to both long sides of each  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide green-on-black check strip. Press the seams toward the green-on-black strips. Make two strip set. Cut  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide segments, 50 total.
5. Sew one segment from step 3 between two segments from step 4 to make a center unit. Make 25 center units. (Set aside 12 units for block B.)
6. Make 52 side units using the red little-berries square and the half-square units from step 1.
7. Sew four half-square units from step 2, four side units, and one center unit together to make block A. Make 13 A blocks.

### **BLOCK B**

8. Use the red-and-black vine squares and the cream rectangles to make 60 units. (Set aside 12 units for border block C.)

9. Sew four half-square units from step 2 of block A, four units from step 8, and one center unit from step 5 together to make block B. Make 12 B blocks.

### **BORDER BLOCK C, D AND CORNER BLOCKS**

10. Use the black-on-gray check and the green little-berries squares to make 88 half-square triangle units. (Set aside 32 units for border block D and 8 units for corner blocks.)

11. Sew four half-square units from step 10, two half-square units from step 2, one unit from step 8, and one green-on-black check square together to make border block C. Make 12 of border block C.

12. Sew four half-square units from step 10, two half-square units from step 1, two half-square units from step 2, one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cream square, and one green-on-black check square together to make border block D. Make 8 of border block D.

13. Sew two half-square units from step 10, one half-square unit from step 2, and one green-on-black vine square together to make a corner block. Make 4 corner blocks.

## Quilt Assembly ~

Follow the assembly instructions for the Holiday Quilt to sew the blocks together and then sew the border to the quilt. Bind to finish.
