Play Date - Block of the Month Play Date Crossing Leaves Mini-Quilt

Using her Play Date and Grandma's Garden fabrics from P&B Textiles

Quilt Size: 27 1/2" - Block Size: 8"



Yardage

Block ~

(10—15) 5" squares (light-medium and medium-dark prints, including one yellow and one green) (1) 9" square of cream (CSNE 01N)

Mini-Quilt ~

- (21) 5" squares for blocks (954B, 954C, 954G, 954P, 955B, 955C, 955G, 955J, 955Y, 957B, 957P, 957O, 958 B, 958P, 958Y, 959J, 959P, 959Y, 960B, 960J, and 960P)
- 1 fat eighth (9" x 21") of (16) Play Date prints for outer border (954B, 954C, 954G, 954P, 955B, 955C, 955G, 955J, 957P, 958B, 958Y, 959P, 959Y, 960B, and 960J)
- 1/4 yard of yellow (GGAR 794Y) for inner border
- 3/8 yard of cream solid (CSNE 01N) for blocks and sashing corners
- 1/2 yard of purple floral (GGAR 793C) for sashing and binding
- 1 yard of any Play Date fabric for backing

Cutting

For each block:

From the cream (CSNE 01N), cut: 1 square, 9" x 9"

Mini-Quilt:

From the purple floral, cut:
4 binding strips, 2" x 42"
12 sashing rectangles, 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

From the cream, cut:
9 squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

From the yellow, cut:
2 strips, 1 1/2" x 19 1/2"
2 strips, 1 1/2" x 21 1/2"

From each of 4 of the fat eighths, cut:
1 square, 4" x 4" (4 total)

From each of the remaining fat eighths, cut:
1 rectangle, 4" x 7 1/2" (12 total)

Construction

Block: (Refer to photo as needed)

- 1. Use the pattern pieces to make appliqué templates. Use the 5" squares, fusible web, and the appliqué templates to prepare 28 leaves, 4 stems, and 1 center. (Or use the appliqué method of your choice.)
- For each block, position the appliqué pieces in the center of each 9" cream square. Fuse the appliqués to the square and finish the edges with decorative stitching.
- 3. Press the block and trim to 8 1/2" square keeping the appliqué motif centered within the square.
- 4. Repeat steps 1 3 to make a total of four blocks.

Mini-Quilt Assembly

- 5. Sew together three 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" purple rectangles and two blocks, alternating them to make a block row. Make two block rows.
- 6. Sew together three 1 1/2" cream squares and two 1 1/2" x 8 1/2' purple rectangles, alternating them to make a sashing row.

 Make three rows.
- 7. Sew the sashing rows and blocks rows together, alternating them as shown in the photo.
- 8. Sew a 19 1/2" yellow inner-border strip to each side of the quilt top; press. Sew a 21 1/2" yellow inner-border strip to the top and bottom edges.
- Sew three 4" x 7 1/2" rectangles together end to end to make a border strip; press. Make 4 border strips.
- 10. Sew a border strip to each side of the quilt top; press. Sew a 4" square to the ends of each remaining border strip and sew them to the top and bottom edges; press.
- 11. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.

 Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish. Add a label to the back of your quilt and enjoy!
