Play Date - Block of the Month Play Date Ring of Hearts Mini-Quilt

Using her Play Date and Grandma's Garden fabrics from P&B Textiles

Quilt Size: 28 1/2" - Block Size: 8"



Yardage

Block ~

- (6) 5" squares (one yellow, four heart prints, and one print for corner triangles)
- (1) 9" square of cream (CSNE 01N)

Mini-Quilt ~

- (20) 5" squares for blocks (954B, 954C, 954G, 955B, 955C, 955J, 955Y, 957B, 958B, 958P, 959P, 959Y, 960B, 960J, 793B, 793C, 793T, 794G, 794Y and 795Y)
- 1/4 yard of small pink floral (PDAT 957P) for blocks and sashing
- 1/4 yard of pink girls (PDAT 954P) for outer border
- 5/8 yard of cream solid (CSNE 01N) for blocks and borders
- 2/3 yard of aqua star-flowers (PDAT 955G) for sashing square, outer border, and binding 1 yard of any *Play Date* fabric for backing

Cutting

For each block:

From the cream (CSNE 01N), cut:
1 square, 9" x 9"
From the small pink floral, cut:
4 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Mini-Quilt:

From the small pink floral, cut:
12 sashing rectangles, 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
From the cream, cut:
1 strip, 2 7/8" x 30"
1 strip, 2 3/4" x 30"
2 strips, 1 1/2" x 21 1/2"
2 strips, 1 1/2" x 19 1/2"
From the aqua star-flower, cut:
4 binding strips, 2" x 42"
1 strip, 2 1/4" x 30"
1 strip, 1 3/4" x 30"
1 strip, 1 1/8" x 30"
1 strip, 1 1/8" x 30"

4 squares, 4" x4" 9 squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" From the pink girls, cut: 1 strip, 3 3/8 x 30" 1 strip, 2 1/4" x 30"

Construction


Block (Refer to photo as needed)

- Use the pattern pieces to make appliqué templates. Use the 5" squares, fusible web, and the appliqué templates to prepare 4 hearts and 4 ring sections. (Or use the appliqué method of your choice.)
- 2. For each block, position the appliqué pieces in the center of each 9" cream square. Fuse the appliqués to the square and finish the edges with decorative stitching.
- 3. Press the block and trim to 8 1/2" square keeping the appliqué motif centered within the square.
- 4. Repeat steps 1 3 to make a total of four blocks.

Mini-Quilt Assembly

- 5. Sew together three 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" pink floral rectangles and two blocks, alternating them to make a block row. Make two block rows.
- 6. Sew together three 1 1/2" aqua squares and two 1 1/2" x 8 1/2' pink floral rectangles, alternating them to make a sashing row.

 Make three rows.
- Sew the sashing rows and blocks rows together, alternating them as shown in the photo.
- 8. Sew a 19 1/2" cream inner-border strip to each side of the quilt top; press. Sew a 21 1/2" cream inner-border strip to the top and bottom edges.
- 9. To make strip set A, sew the 2 1/4" aqua strip to one long side of the 2 1/4" pink strip; press. Crosscut the strip set into 12 segments, 2 1/4" wide.
- 10. To make strip set B, sew the 1 5/8" aqua strip to one long side of the 2 7/8" cream strip; press. Crosscut the strip set into 12 segments, 2 1/4" wide.
- 11. To make strip set C, sew the 1 1/8" aqual strip to one long side of the 3 3/8" pink strip; press. Crosscut the strip set into 12 segments, 2 1/4" wide.
- 12. To make strip set D, sew the 1 3/4" aqua strip to one long side of the 2 3/4" cream strip; press. Crosscut the strip set into 12 segments, 2 1/4" wide.
- 13. Sew one segment from each strip set together as shown below to make a border block. Make 12 blocks.
- 14. Sew three border blocks together as shown in the photo to make a border strip; press. Make four.
- 15. Sew a border strip to each side of the quilt top; press. Sew a 4" aqua square to the both ends of each remaining border strip and sew them to the top and bottom edges; press.
- 16. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish. Add a label to the back of your quilt and enjoy!
