Supply list

Fabrics (for block only**)

- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of light print for background,
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of green print for stem and leaf appliqués
- 1 fat quarter *each* of 2 coordinating colors for flower appliqués
- $\frac{1}{8}$ yard of yellow print for appliqués

Other materials

- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards of 12"-wide Misfyuse fusible web*
- $\frac{3}{8}$ " bias tape maker for making stems
- Water-soluble fabric/appliqué glue (Quilter's Choice, Glue-baste-it, or Jillily Studio). A glue stick is *not* suitable.*
- Thread to match appliqués (I prefer 60-wt thread; however 50-wt thread is also suitable.)
- 70/10 Microtex Sharp sewing machine needles
- Reynolds brand parchment paper (18" or larger piece)
- \$5.00 materials fee payable in class for placement guide

**Fusible web and appliqué glue are available for purchase in class (cash or checks only).*

General sewing supplies

- Sewing machine with blanket or zigzag stitch and appropriate presser foot
- Sharp scissors for cutting fabric
- Paper scissors for cutting fusible web
- Iron and ironing board
- Any other favorite tools you like to have on hand when sewing

Before Class - Cutting

From light background print, cut:

- (1) 25" square
