### Supply list

## Fabrics (for block only\*\*)

- 3/4 yard of light print for background,
- ½ yard of green print for stem and leaf appliqués
- 1 fat quarter *each* of 2 coordinating colors for flower appliqués
- 1/8 yard of yellow print for appliqués

#### Other materials

- 1 1/4 yards of 12"-wide Misyfuse fusible web\*
- 3/8" bias tape maker for making stems
- Water-soluble fabric/appliqué glue (Quilter's Choice, Glue-baste-it, or Jillily Studio). A glue stick is not suitable.\*
- Thread to match appliqués (I prefer 60-wt thread; however 50-wt thread is also suitable.)
- 70/10 Microtex Sharp sewing machine needles
- Reynolds brand parchment paper (18" or larger piece)
- \$5.00 materials fee payable in class for placement guide

#### General sewing supplies

- Sewing machine with blanket or zigzag stitch and appropriate presser foot
- Sharp scissors for cutting fabric
- Paper scissors for cutting fusible web
- Iron and ironing board
- Any other favorite tools you like to have on hand when sewing

#### **Before Class - Cutting**

From light background print, cut:

• (1) 25" square
