Block size: 6" x 6"

## Supply List

*Fat eighths measure 9" x 21". Select fabrics with good contrast between the light and dark prints.*

1 fat eighth *each* of 11 assorted A prints

1 fat eighth *each* of 10 assorted B prints

## Cutting for Four Block Candle Mat

*How much you get done in class will depend on how fast you sew and how proficient you are at paper foundation piecing. You may have enough time in class to make more than four blocks, so you may want to cut out enough to make an additional four blocks.*

**From each of 10 A prints, cut:**

(4) 2" x 5½" rectangles (40 total)

**From the remaining A print, cut:**

(4) 2¾" squares

**From each dark print, cut:**

(4) 2" x 5½" rectangles (40 total)

## Tools

- Rotary Cutter (45 mm or small cutter)
- Cutting Mat (12" x 18" or larger)
- Rulers:
  - 6" x 12" ruler (or larger)
  - 1" x 12" ruler or 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler
- Wooden Pressing tool
- Washable glue stick
